# **School and Community**

Founded in 1998, Isikkent School is a K-12, independent, national, co-ed, day and boarding school which strives to create an international and multi-cultural environment under the auspices of Cimentas Health and Education Foundation with a mission to educate aspiring global citizens.

Isikkent School provides a well-rounded education with a balance of the academic, sporting and artistic domains.

Isikkent School emphasizes the "value-added" concept with student-oriented learning, building on each individual's spheres of talent.

Officially accredited by the IB for PYP, MYP and DP, Isikkent School is the only institution offering these programs in the Aegean area and one of the 8 schools in Turkey.

To be a pioneering school that builds bridges between people and cultures through experiential learning.

#### **Mission**

Işikkent School develops international minded, effective multi-lingual communicators and reflective, self-confident, principled individuals by offering an innovative, research and inquiry-based education through combining the national curriculum with international programs.

# Philosophy

The educational experience at Isikkent is student centered, ensuring that students experience continual intellectual, social—emotional, and physical development within a safe psychological and physical environment.

The student experience is based on continuous assessment of current understanding and research-based educational



approaches that develop critical thinking skills and view the student as an active reflective participant in their own learning process.

The Isikkent teacher is a facilitator and promoter of learning as well as a designer and implementer of student-centered activities.


The teacher develops a nurturing relationship with the students, reinforced by the school support system, to ensure student intellectual, social-emotional and physical development. Teachers model life-long learning through regular professional development and professional reading and discussion.

It is through this repeated pattern of assessment, teaching and learning, and support that develops our students into lifelong learners.

#### **Enrollment**

A limited number of students are admitted to the high school each year, on the basis of their achievement in the highly competitive national exam taken by over 1,000,000 students, as well as their performance in a consequent interview with academic staff and school counselor.

#### Curriculum

High School is a 1+4-year (Prep Class + Grade 9 to 12) Anatolian High School. Students enter Grade 9 only if they pass the English Placement Test at the beginning of their high school education. Students with limited or lower English level are placed in the Prep Program for a year. After a year of intensive English preparation, students follow a common core curriculum in Grade 9 and 10 within the IB-MYP program. From Grade 11 onwards, the curriculum becomes more specific based on the choice of four Science/Math, possible diploma tracks; Turkish/Math, Turkish/Social Sciences, and IB-DP. All students in the Science-Math and Turkish-Math tracks follow an advanced mathematics curriculum consisting of Algebra, Trigonometry, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, and Calculus. Students in the IB-DP program follow the IB-DP curriculum.

At Isikkent, the first foreign language is English whereas the students have the opportunity to study a second foreign language such as French, German or Spanish after they finish Grade 4.

All students at Isikkent follow the PYP - Primary Years Program (ranging from Age 3 to Grade 4) and MYP - Middle Year Program (ranging from Grade 5 to Grade10). They receive their PYP Certificates at the end of Grade 4 completing the PYP Exhibition and in Grade 10; they obtain the MYP Certificates on completion of the MYP Personal Project.

Students who choose DP (Diploma Program) in Grade 11 and 12, gain the internationally recognized Diploma in addition to their Turkish National Diploma upon completing the internal assessments and external IB exams. Students who choose the National Curriculum (MEB) take the national university entrance exam to continue their higher education.

The IBDP Diploma and The National Curriculum (MEB) Diploma are both internationally recognized documents and valid for university entrance.

Opportunities for personal development and leadership expand in the Middle School and High School through the extensive community service (MYP-Service as Action and DP-CAS), after school programs, personal projects, arts and sports activities.

# **Grading**

Students receive grades at the end of each semester and the final year grade is the average of the two semesters' grades. GPA's are weighted and they are calculated by multiplying the exam grades by the number of course hours of each subject. The passing mark is 50%. "Certificate of Academic High Honors" is obtained by a weighted average of 85%. "Certificate of Academic Honors" is obtained by a weighted average of 70%.

Isikkent does not report rank. GPA is calculated by weighting each subject based on its hour of study per week.

The chart below demonstrates the cumulative GPA 9-10-11 distribution of the class of 2023




The chart below is the grade distribution for the junior year (11th grade) of our present 12th grade students.

#### **External Tests**

Isikkent High School is a College Board Test Center; offering PSAT/SAT and AP Exams. PSAT 8/9 Exams are offered to Grade 9 Students and PSAT/NMQST Exams are taken by Grade 10-11 Students every year. Isikkent opens its doors to students who would like to take SAT Exams from around the world 6 times a year. Although AP Curriculum is not an option at Isikkent, students may choose to take AP Exams in May. IELTS Exams are given every November and May when high school students perform with their high English knowledge level.



# **After School Programs**

Isikkent students are actively involved in a wide variety of After School Programs, covering a range of activities in the fields of sports, fine arts, science & technology, community service, personal development and academic support. The most popular clubs are Model United Nations (MUN), Theater (English and Turkish), Destination Imagination, Junior Achievement, Swimming, Basketball and Volleyball many of which give the students the chance to compete nationally and internationally.

Performing arts include drama, poetry, folklore and dance, the pop music band and the classical music orchestra. Visual arts clubs include pottery, puppet making, graphic and design.

After School Programs are supported by the school's facilities situated in 14,000 square meters of green area, a 550-seat amphitheater and a 450-seat conference hall. The school has excellent sports facilities, including a heated indoor semi-Olympic size swimming pool, gymnasium, indoor and outdoor basketball, volleyball complexes and a tennis court.

# **Community Service**


Community Service has an integral part in the fulfilment of the school's mission at Isikkent. Students can choose to participate in Interact or the C&S Committee to take part in various projects or directly consult the Vice-Principal to start an independent project.

Işikkent has involved in various individual projects, all initiated by students, from building libraries in village schools and organizing campaigns to donate wheelchairs for the disabled or hand-made rag dolls to the Turkish Psychological Association to pioneering the "Isikkent Forest" as part of their eco-school project. Grade 9 and 10 students are also required to meet the curriculum requirements of the Service as Action prescribed by the IB MYP Programme. In Grades 11 and 12 IB DP students are actively engaged into the CAS activity required by the IBDP Programme.

#### **IEK Alumni Association**

"Isikkent Alumni Association" was established to strengthen the collaboration, communication, and links between graduates, students, and community members. The aim of the association is to develop a sense of belonging in IEK graduates by gathering them under the same roof and contributing to the development of the school by carrying out activities appropriate to its vision and mission. With this aim in mind, the association organizes various activities every year for graduates, whose number has reached 591.
