

IŞIKKENT SCHOOL PROFILE 2019 - 2020







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School and Community

Founded in 1998, Isikkent School is a K-12, independent, national, co-ed, day and boarding school which strives to create an international and multi-cultural environment under the auspices of Cimentas Health and Education Foundation with a mission to educate aspiring global citizens.

Ilsikkent School provides a well-rounded education with a balance of the academic, sporting and artistic domains.

Isikkent School emphasizes the "value-added" concept with student-oriented learning, building on each individual's spheres of talent.

Officially accredited by the IB for PYP, MYP and DP, Isikkent School is the only institution offering these programs in the Aegean area and one of the 8 schools in Turkey.

Vision

To be a pioneering school that builds bridges between people and cultures through experiential learning.

Mission

Işıkkent School develops international minded, effective multi-lingual communicators and reflective, self-confident, principled individuals by offering an innovative, research and inquiry-based education through combining the national curriculum with international programs.

Philosophy

The educational experience at Isikkent is student centered, ensuring that students experience continual intellectual, social–emotional, and physical development within a safe psychological and physical environment.

The student experience is based on continuous assessment of current understanding and research-based educational approaches that develop critical thinking skills and view the student as an active reflective participant in their own learning process.

The Isikkent teacher is a facilitator and promoter of learning as well as a designer and implementer of student-centered activities.

The teacher develops a nurturing relationship with the students, reinforced by the school support system, to ensure student intellectual, social-emotional and physical development. Teachers model life-long learning through regular professional development and professional reading and discussion.

It is through this repeated pattern of assessment, teaching and learning, and support that develops our students into lifelong learners.

Enrollment

A limited number of students are admitted to the high school each year, on the basis of their achievement in the highly competitive national exam taken by over 1,000,000 students, as well as their performance in a consequent interview with academic staff and school counselor.



Faculty

116 teaching staff (109 full time and 7 part time). 30 hold graduate degrees.

13 are native English speakers, 2 are native Spanish speakers and 1 is a native French speaker.

Student to teacher ratio is 6 and average class size is 18.

Students

There are 716 students in Isikkent from ages 3 to 18, namely in grades ELC 1 to 12th grade. There are 66 students in ELC; 154 students in Primary School; 212 students in Middle School; 284 students in High School.

Our new boarding facility houses students who come from different parts of Turkey. 30 students are presently residing in our boarding house.

99.8 % of Isikkent Graduates (from 2009 to 2019) attend four-year universities.

60% of 2019 Graduates applied and received acceptances from overseas universities.

56% of 2019 Graduates preferred to continue their education at universities abroad.

Curriculum

High School is a 1+4-year (Prep Class + Grade 9 to 12) Anatolian High School. Students enter Grade 9 only if they pass the English Placement Test at the beginning of their high school education. Students with limited or less English level are placed in the Prep Program for a year. After a year of intensive English preparation, students follow a common core curriculum in Grade 9 and 10. From Grade 10 onwards, the curriculum becomes more specific based on the choice of three possible diploma tracks; Science/Math, Turkish/Math, and Turkish/Social Sciences. All students in the Science-Math and Turkish-Math tracks follow an advanced mathematics curriculum consisting of Algebra, Trigonometry, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, and Calculus.

At Isikkent, the first foreign language is English whereas the students have the opportunity to study a second foreign language such as French, Spanish or Italian after they finish Grade 4.

All students at Isikkent study the PYP - Primary Years Program (ranging from Age 3 to Grade 4) and MYP -Middle Year Program (ranging from Grade 5 to Grade 10). They receive their PYP Certificates at the end of Grade 4 completing the PYP Exhibition and in Grade 10; they obtain the MYP Certificates on completion of the MYP Personal Project.




In Grade 12 the students who follow and then complete successfully the IBDP program receive the IBDP Diploma. All these certificates have an international equivalency which gives students a chance to study abroad if they prefer.

In Grades 11 and 12 students have the right to choose their streams. They can study the DP (Diploma Program) and gain the internationally recognized Diploma apart from their Turkish National Diploma completing the external IB exams, or they can stay in the national program and get ready for the national university examinations. Both programs are very challenging and they prepare students for their future higher education needs.

Opportunities for personal development and leadership expand in the high school through the extensive community service, after school program, personal projects and sports.

Grading

Students receive grades at the end of each semester and the final year grade is the average of the two semesters' grades. GPA's are weighted and they are calculated by multiplying the exam grades by the number of course hours of each subject.

The passing mark is 50%.

High Honors Degree is obtained by a weighted average of 85%.

Honors Degree is obtained by a weighted average of 70%.

Isikkent does not report rank. GPA is calculated by weighting each subject based on its hour of study per week.

After School Programs

Isikkent students are actively involved in a wide variety They can choose to participate in Interact or the C&S in the fields of sports, fine arts, science & technology, community service, personal development and academic support. The most popular clubs are Model United Nations (MUN), Theater (English and Turkish), Destination Imagination, Junior Achievement, Swimming, Basketball and Volleyball many of which give internationally.

Performing arts include drama, poetry, folklore and dance, the pop music band and the classical music orchestra. Visual arts clubs include pottery, puppet activity required by the IBDP Programme. making, graphic and design.

After School Programs are supported by the school's facilities situated in 14,000 square meters of green area, a 450-seat amphitheater and a 450-seat conference hall. The school has excellent sports facilities, including a heated indoor semi-Olympic size swimming pool, gymnasium, indoor and outdoor basketball, volleyball complexes and a tennis court.

Community Service

Community Service has an integral part in the fulfilment of the school's mission and Isikkent students have to complete certain hours of community service every year.
